Attendance Awareness Campaign Webinar #1 Discussion Guide April 2, 2025

Below are a suggested set of discussion questions for schools and communities to reflect upon insights gained from this webinar. Feel free to use some or all of the questions to prompt a rich conversation about how to take action.

Chronic absence in your community

- 1. What are the levels of chronic absence in your community? If you don't know, how can you get that data?
- 2. Are there particular grades, schools or student groups who are especially affected by chronic absence?
- 3. What are the biggest challenges and barriers affecting student attendance in your community?

District and school teams

- 1. Do you currently have in place a team (district and/or school team) that focuses on attendance and the implementation of a school-wide strategy for reducing chronic absenteeism? If not, how can you start one?
- 2. If so, who is part of that team? How regularly is the team meeting?
- 3. Who within your school or district needs to be engaged to ensure a district-wide or school-wide approach tailored to the needs of your community? (Consider the role of principals, school nurses, teachers, district offices, unions, expanded learning providers, transportation, etc.).

Cultivating allies

- 1. Who do you need to be working with externally to improve attendance in your school and community?
- 2. What information and resources do you plan to take back to your school and community from this webinar?
